

Scat Rhythms for Blues Improvisation

Instructions:

- Get comfortable with these blues rhythms by practicing them using the scat syllables provided.
Notice that some of the examples are swung and some are in straight four time.
- Using these rhythms, improvise a melody using the requested blues pentascale.
Notice the use of the Bar form phrasing (AAB). Phrase three (B) MUST begin on the dominant note and end on the tonic note.
- Accompany your improvisation with a minor 7th following the harmonic plan provided on the score.
- Perform with the play-along audio tracks.
